Target group:

Early career researchers/scientists* developing groundbreaking ideas and innovative solutions for big challenges in waste management

*PhD-students (thesis, which is in the final phase (already evaluated)) or Postgraduates (thesis not older than four years)

Application documents:

- CV and contact details
- max 3-page summary of thesis/project/idea
- motivation letter, where the candidate has to state why the work is outstanding, innovative/ground-breaking and important for waste management
- pdf of thesis/project report/concept
- letter of recommendation by supervisor

Grant/Award:

Free IWWG membership for one year, free entrance to the Sardinia Symposium 2021, support of travel costs to the conference (300 for Europeans, 700 outside Europe) if the pandemic allows travelling and joining the Conference in person.

The winner of the award is invited to orally present his/her thesis/idea at the Sardinia Symposium 2021 in a 10 min time-slot either during the opening session or closing session (online or in physical presence (depending on the pandemic situation), and to prepare a poster that highlights the vision, which will be exhibited during the entire conference!

Criteria:

The applications will be evaluated by a jury consisting of delegates from the IWWG Managing Board. Criteria for evaluating the applications are:

- Relevance of topic for waste management
- Originality of topic/solution finding approach
- Innovation character/groundbreaking idea of the work
