SUMMER INTENSIVE PROGRAMME

PROGRAMME STARTING DATE 10 July 2024

The summer intensive Croatian language learning programme for foreigners will be held every working day from 10 to 31 July 2024 in the University of Applied Sciences Velika Gorica's lecture halls and classrooms. The programme will be held according to the following schedule, taking into consideration the professional, student, and personal obligations of the participants:
