## BASIC COURSE (A1 and A2)

## **COURSE STARTING DATE 15 September 2025**

The course in Croatian language for foreigners will be held every working day from 15 September to 20 December 2025 in the lecture halls of the University of Applied Sciences Velika Gorica. The course will be held according to the following schedule (three times per week), depending on the professional, student, and private obligations of the attendees:

- 1. in the morning from 9:00 to 12:00 and/or
- 2. in the afternoon from 17:00 to 20:00.

## BASIC COURSE (A1 and A2)

## COURSE STARTING DATE 12 January 2026

The course in Croatian language for foreigners will be held every working day from 12 January to 20 April 2026 in the lecture halls of the University of Applied Sciences Velika Gorica. The course will be held according to the following schedule (three times per week), depending on the professional, student, and private obligations of the attendees:

- 1. in the morning from 9:00 to 12:00 and/or
- 2. in the afternoon from 17:00 to 20:00.

This course represents an excellent opportunity for workers, employers and students, enabling participants to acquire new knowledge of the Croatian language that will facilitate their integration into the work environment.

The A1 level course covers content from the fields of Croatian language, communication, and culture. It consists of a total of 140 hours of lectures and exercises in person with a Croatian language teacher, divided into two modules – A 1.1. (70 hours) and A 1.2. (70 hours) – and independent work at home. After completing the course, the attendees acquire proficiency in Croatian at the preparatory level (A1) according to the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages and they are awarded a course completion certificate.

The A2 level course covers content from the fields of Croatian language, communication, and culture. It consists of a total of 140 hours of lectures and exercises in person with a Croatian language teacher, divided into two modules – A 2.1. (70 hours) and A 2.2. (70 hours) – and independent work at home. After completing the course, the attendees

acquire proficiency in Croatian at the preparatory level (A2) according to the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages and they are awarded a course completion certificate.
