Objectives and description:	<p>Objectives of the program include introduction to EU crisis management, sustainability in the context of prevention and response to crisis situations and development of language and academic skills in an international environment. This will be done through online lectures and practical work which includes planning, preparation and construction of a temporary tent settlement, including moving equipment and supplies, setting up the site, furnishing the tent settlement, organizing life and work; teaching and learning under field conditions; practical training and use of civil defense equipment and resources.</p> <p>Online classes before the physical mobility which will introduce students to theoretical concepts of camp preparation, crisis management, sustainability and collaborative work in field conditions. They will be introduced to the task and field exercise and organized into groups. Mobility week will consist of orientation lecture at host institution, social events and three day stay at the camp. Camp activities will include lectures and exercises on first aid, topography and communications, decontamination, camp coordination and management. Final day will take place at the host institution where groups of students will present their work.</p>
Methods and outcomes:	<p>Students will attend online classes before the physical mobility which will introduce them to the theoretical concepts of camp preparation, crisis management, sustainability and collaborative work in field conditions. The lectures will be delivered by teachers from partner institutions using online tools for course delivery. Mobility week will consist of orientation lecture at host institution, social events and three day stay at the camp where students will learn practical skills and undergo exercises. Students will be organized into project groups and will have to deliver a report on the final day of mobility.</p> <p>At the end of the program, students will receive theoretical and practical knowledge in sustainable crisis management, humanitarian aid efforts, first aid techniques and camp management. They will develop their academic communication and collaboration skills. The program will award students with 3 ECTS.</p>
Virtual Component Description:	Online classes will be held between May 13 and May 20, 2024, before the physical mobility. Students will be introduced to theoretical concepts of camp preparation, crisis management, sustainability and collaborative work in field conditions. Classes will include soft skills such as language and communication and academic reading and writing. The online classes

	will be delivered using moodle and other online course delivery tools. The classes will be delivered by teachers from partner institutions.
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
